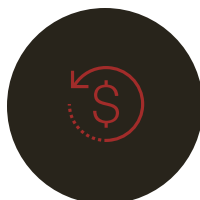
Major Employers are D&W Fine Pack, Martin Marietta, Abes Trash Service, and Fort Calhoun Schools.

Population



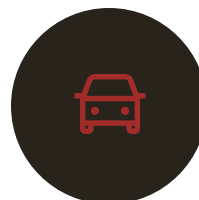
