The Village of Herman lies on Highway 75, 10 miles north of Blair (population 8091) and 8 miles south of Tekamah (Burt County seat, population 1,723). Herman was platted in 1871 when the railroad was extended to that point.[6] It was named for Samuel Herman, a railroad employee.

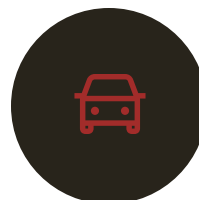
