Kennard was laid out by the Sioux City & Pacific Railroad Company in 1869 upon the completion of the line to that point, and was named for Nebraska's first Secretary of State Thomas Kennard.

The Vision Statement includes, "The Village of Kennard, Nebraska provides a close-knit community of neighbors and friends who look out for each other." This community lies on Highway 30, less than 7 miles west of Blair, and is less than 5 miles to Highway 133.
