The Village of Washington was platted in 1887 when the Fremont, Elkhorn and Missouri Valley Railroad was extended to that point. It was named from Washington County. Washington was incorporated as a village in 1915. The Village has a total area of .021 square miles, and sits 6 miles east of highway 31 and 5 miles northwest of the growing community of Bennington, in Douglas County.

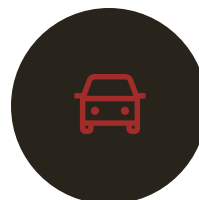
